Good afternoon EJ Families,

This afternoon, our district received news of a presumed positive case of COVID with an EJ Elementary staff member. Unfortunately, contact tracing was stopped after realizing that she might have been in contact with multiple classrooms during the time of her possible contagious period. Individual staff and students are receiving letters of notification on this possible exposure this afternoon and Mrs. Hager will be following up with those families. If you did not hear directly from the district already, your child was not in close contact.

Elementary students are being sent home with devices today to support remote learning during the next 2 weeks.

Using the guidance from the Jackson County Health Department, EJ Elementary will be closed to in-person instruction for 2 weeks with plans to reopen for in-person instruction on Monday, Jan. 25, 2021. EJSS will remain open to in-person instruction during this time.

EJSS families, please note that there will be a half day for students on Monday, Jan. 11 to allow EJ Staff to receive the COVID-19 vaccination. Students will be released at 11:50am. The normal schedule for secondary students will resume on Tuesday, Jan. 12.

Please note that the food service director, Mrs. Delosh, is planning for remote food service for elementary students during the building closure, however further information is pending at this time.
